California's State Legislature Voted to Increase Community College Enrollment Fees from \$20 to \$26 Per Unit Beginning in the Fall 2009 Semester

- **California's new 2009-10 Budget mandates a fee increase from \$20 to 26 per unit** for all community college students starting with Fall 2009 semester classes.
- **Ask if you are eligible for a Board of Governors Fee Waiver** or ask about other financial aid options at our Financial Aid Counter, 1st Floor, Admissions area.

Annual California community college enrollment fees still are one of the best higher education bargains nationwide, and compared to the annual fees for attending the UC and CSU systems.

Community colleges provide an excellent option for finishing your college freshman and sophomore years. You can then transfer to four-year universities to finish your final two years of college and earn your bachelor's degree. The annual 2009-10 fee for community colleges, California state universities, and the UC system are:

- California Community Colleges \$ 780 (30 Units)
- California State University \$4,827
- University of California \$8,720
